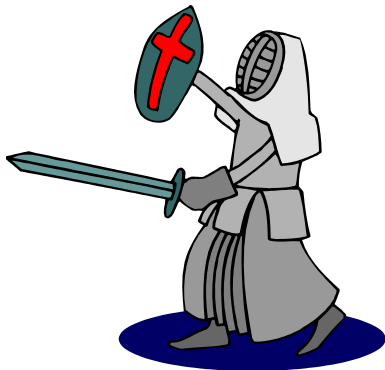


Why have an Elder?

- ❖ *An opportunity to find others who have the same interests as you.*
- ❖ *Learn (perhaps more than you wanted to know) about the many and varied activities within the SCA.*



What May be expected of you as a Novice

- ❖ *Share your interests with your Elder.*
- ❖ *If you are looking for an SCA mom, be clear. There will be folks uncomfortable with that role and others that may enjoy it.*
- ❖ *Ask about activities, events, and arts or sciences activities.*
- ❖ *Attend perhaps 2 events with your Elder. They may not be your constant companion but will leave you from time to time to visit with others or observe activities.*
- ❖ *Try to make one event an event with a Royal Presence. Learn as much as possible about court activities and manners.*
- ❖ *Make contact on your own with your Elder.*
- ❖ *Commit to perhaps 6 months total.*
