

2018 REGIONAL AND KINGDOM A&S FAIRE RULES

- Entries will be judged using the new criteria.
- Judging will be done face-to-face if possible.
- All entrants will receive their comment sheets, and scores will be recorded separately so as to determine who is eligible for Kingdom A&S.
- We will not be awarding first, second, and third places.
- Scores will not be provided on the day of the Faire. Requests must be emailed to the Regional MOAS. Scores will then be provided as the average score the entry earned in each section.
- If someone submits a non-Pentathlon entry, they should expect to help with the judging.
- Mail-in categories must be email by January 15, 2018.
- The general rules are also in effect and can be found as a link on KMOAS website.
- Entrants are expected to not plagiarize; guidance on plagiarism can be found a link on KMOAS website.

Individual Entries: Regional Faires

- The five entries in each region with the highest score will be announced in alphabetical order. This excludes entries associated with winning Pentathlon.
- Non-Pentathlon entries can be entered into any regional faire.

Divisional entries:

- There will be no Divisional Champions for 2018 fair.

Pentathlon Entries: Regional Faires

- Each contestant will be allowed only one Pentathlon entry consisting of no more than five entries.
- The contestant must have scores in five categories drawn from at least four separate divisions, with entries in no more than two categories in any one division.
- All entries used in a regional Pentathlon championship must score higher than 19 points to be eligible to participate at the Kingdom Pentathlon Championship.
- Pentathlons must be entered into the entrant's home region's faire.
- The top scoring Pentathlon will be named as the Regional A&S Champion.

Kingdom Faire

- The Kingdom Faire will be limited to fifty individual entries and to six Pentathlon entries.
- For individual entries, after the final Regional Faire, a list of scores from all of the faires will be compiled by division. Each division will be awarded a number of spots at the Kingdom Faire based on the division's percentage of total entries. (If there are a total of 100 entries and Division 1 has 50 entries, they will receive half (25) of the total entries to the Kingdom Faire.) The spots will be made available in the order that the entries finished.
- At the Kingdom Faire, the top three non-Pentathlon scoring pieces in each Division will be announced.

- The top scoring Pentathlon from each region will advance to the Kingdom Faire, provided that all five entries meet the minimum score requirement.
- After the last Pentathlon, the top Pentathlon from across the kingdom that did not win their regional faire will also advance to the Kingdom Faire. Additional Kingdom
- Pentathlon spots may become open if a region does not have one advance, or if a regional champion decides not to advance to the Kingdom Faire.
- A Pentathlon entry that did not qualify for the Kingdom Faire may have its component entries changed to individual entries and have them entered into the pool for advancement to the Kingdom Faire as individual entries.
- At the Kingdom Faire the Pentathlon entries will be announced in reverse order (highest score announced last).
