Greetings all you who like to eat or Cook

The Silver Spoons has been busy the last month. We had an outdoor cookout where everything was fixed over an open fire. Everything fixed was things that could be prepared at Pennsic and not necessarily period recipes. Alexander fixed Chicken Chili in a dutch oven and I fixed a Pineapple Upside-down Cake in a dutch oven. I also fixed vegetables over the open fire, everyone seemed to like the carrots best, but they ate everything. The Baroness and Ma fixed different kinds of Chicken, and Bronwen fixed cabbage rolls which can also be cooked in a dutch oven. Susan fixed a dessert with fresh Rhubarb. We had a nice day and a nice cookout at Susan's House. Lots of room to fight there also!? We also cooked lunch for Hrodgiersfjodr's demo at the Way Library in Perrysburg. Everyone enjoyed the Highland Stew, Pita and Hummas/Tahini, Baklava, and sucunjabun.

Well here we are another month and another subject from the book, "Food" by Waverly Root, I will discuss the "Hare" Hare bones have been found in prehistoric kitchen middens in sites as far apart as New England (Snowshoe rabbit), Russia (blue hare and tailless hare) and also in Africa (the jumping hare). The ancient Hebrews did not eat this animal, for Leviticus 11:4 proscribes it: "He cheweth the cud but divideth not the hoof; he is unclean unto you." But the ancient Romans did, with all the more avidity because they believed that eating hare for seven days straight, would banish ugliness; they kept hare in their game parks, no doubt as aids in beauty. The ancient Greeks thought that eating hare caused insomnia; and indeed Brillat-Savarin two thousand years later said that eating hare provoked dreaming, but added that dreaming was good for the health. In England, Fynes Moryson wrote in the early 17th century that "hares are thought to nourish Melancholy, yet they are eaten as venison both roast and boiled." In medieval times the greyhound was used to hunt hares. The Gauls did not eat rabbit, but they were fond of hare. Hare were eaten roasted when they were young until they became of mating age about 1 year and were thereafter called a buck and were then good for a stew, though the female remains tender until about two. When the hare reaches three (7-8 lbs) it is considered old and is used for pate's and terrines. It is thought that hares that live in hills or mountains are usually tastier than those living on the plains. Hare is not eaten so often in the U.S. as it was even up to the 1960's, but is still eaten elsewhere in the world as it always has been. Until next time try some Hare stewed or roasted for a change in meat. By the way it is said that wild rabbit/hare is better tasting than domesticated. I remain!

Look at your fighters card right now and check it out unless you have already gotten one within the last year, then it should be no problem.

Easy skirt

Submitted by Anna Mailander

Take your hip measurement—multiply by at least 3 (i.e. 40"x3 = 120"=10')

Buy about 3 yards of material for a very full skirt, 2 yds will work too

WASH MATERIAL FIRST

Straighten cut ends Bring these ends together—wrong sides out

Sew seam leaving top end open about 1 to 1 1/2 inches

Turn down top edge to form casing about 1" deep—sew leaving opening open

Thread shoe lace through casing (should be about 30" longer than waist measurement—splice if have to)

Put skirt on—mark length—may need someone else to do that Sew in hem

You are the proud owner of a full gathered skirt

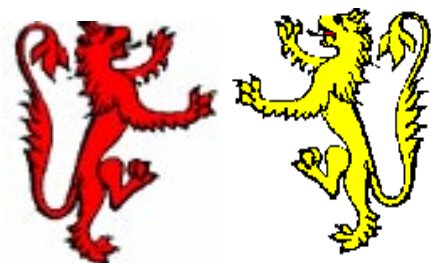
