The SCA Pulls Together to Help Victims of Hurricane Katrina and Rita

The end of August marked the beginning of a series of deadly hurricanes that hit the Gulf Coast this year. Hurricane Katrina brought flood waters and devastation to the southern port cities. People were evacuated and had to leave everything behind. Most lost homes, vehicles, personal belongings, and all the basic necessities of living.

Those outside of the affected areas, scrambled to contact loved ones, offer shelter to refugees, and to organize donation centers. In the first few scattered days, massive amounts of clothing, fresh water, food, and emergency kits were sent. The Kingdom Seneschals began coordinating mass relief efforts in their various Kingdoms. When people began to find stable shelter and started to rebuild their lives, a call went out for extra garb and event supplies.

But just as people were gaining some normalcy, Hurricane Rita reared its ugly head. People were evacuated from their safe havens in Texas and the call for help came out again. People from all over the Known World have been calling in, pulling together much needed supplies, and making road trips to bring the supplies to the affected areas. So much was donated, that the organizers of the donation sites asked people to hold onto their supplies until the supplies that were already stored were moved to the proper locations.

I don't think a day went by during these painful weeks when I did not read through tearful eyes email accounts of heroic deeds and heartfelt thanks from those who received our care. Its times like these when you truly know how lucky we all are to have a community and family in the SCA.


