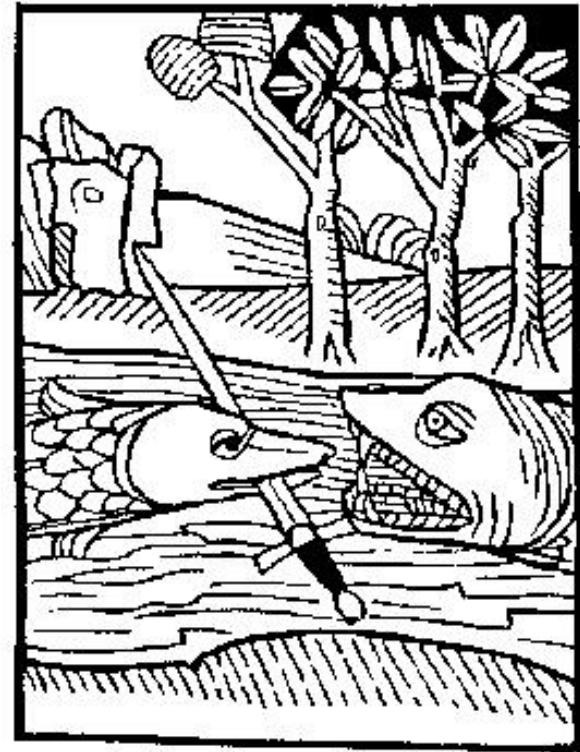

FROM THE KNIGHT'S MARSHAL

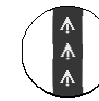
