

Greetings to the people of this Great Kingdom from your Kingdom Webminister...

A word about warrants

Currently, we do not have a roster of warranted webministers. To resolve this problem, I am asking that **every webminister** of an officially recognized group: Canton, Shire, Barony, College, Riding or any other designation – including Incipient – to **send in a change of office form – no matter how long you have been in office. This also includes webministers who are deputies to any Kingdom Officer.** If you maintain an “official” website for any group (other than households), you must send in a completed copy of the Change of Office form.

For those webministers who have been in office for any length of time or for groups with a newly created webminister position, please fill in the **Active Officer** section on the right hand side of the form. Then, have at least your group’s Seneschal (or your superior, in cases of Officers’ pages) sign it. This is the “proof” that you are recognized as the official webminister for your group or for the office.

For new webministers who are taking over the office, please make sure that you have the outgoing webminister (if they are available) fill in the **Resignation** section (the left side of the form), with your information filled in under the **Acting Officer** section.

A word about reports

First, thank you to those webministers who have sent in their third quarter report.

Second, for **all webministers** the reporting requirement is:

January 1 (Domesday)	July 1
April 1	October 1

These reports are necessary for maintaining your warrants. At this point, because of the changeover in the Kingdom Webminister’s office, I am giving all webministers until May 1, 2010 to send in a quarterly report (should be at least two by that date) and to make sure that a completed copy of your Change of Office form is on file with this office. **Any webminister who fails to follow these requirements will have their account access frozen and their warrant pulled.**

This is in compliance with Kingdom Law XVI-1000:

“The failure to send in required reports can be held to serve as a resignation from office by the Great Officer of State that the office reports to. Resignation from office is without prejudice.”

How this affects those webministers who have failed to comply is:

No reports = resignation by default = no warrant; pure and simple.

I wish to thank everyone who has taken on the mantle of webminister. The work you do helps create a positive electronic presence of the SCA and the Midrealm in particular.
