

Greetings to all from your Kingdom Webminister, Lady Finnseach de Locheil!

I hope you all have had a wonderful Winter Holiday and a great New Year!

Have you sent in your Domesday Report? ALL Webministers (Branch, Officer Web Deputies and At-Larges) need to have sent in their Domesday to me by January 1. I will grant a two-week extension, since things are getting hammered out with this office.

By the same token, have you sent in the completed paperwork as requested in my last missive? Because of various factors, I have to re-build the Webminister's files – and need your paperwork to do so. As a quick recap, here's the relevant paragraph from my December letter:

“I am asking that **every webminister** of an officially recognized group: Canton, Shire, Barony, College, Riding or any other designation – including Incipient – to **send in a change of office form – no matter how long you have been in office. This also includes webministers who are deputies to any Kingdom Officer.** If you maintain an “official” website for any group (other than households), you must send in a completed copy of the Change of Office form.”

There are NO exceptions to this requirement. You only have to fill in the **Acting Officer** portion of the form and have it counter-signed by either your group's Seneschal, or the officer who deputized you for their website. This is not an onerous chore, but it will keep your website as “an officially recognized” one representing your group and the SCA. Again, from the December letter...

“For those webministers who have been in office for any length of time or for groups with a newly created webminister position, please fill in the **Active Officer** section on the right hand side of the form. Then, have at least your group's Seneschal (or your superior, in cases of Officers' pages) sign it. This is the “proof” that you are recognized as the official webminister for your group or for the office.”

Any Webminister who fails to send in their paperwork and reports, will not be warranted. This can cause your group's (or officer's) website to no longer be recognized by the Kingdom and hence the Society.

“At this point, because of the changeover in the Kingdom Webminister's office, I am giving all webministers until May 1, 2010 to send in a quarterly report (should be at least two by that date) and to make sure that a completed copy of your Change of Office form is on file with this office.

Any webminister who fails to follow these requirements will have their warrant pulled.”
